Food for Thought...Engaging Students at Risk of Not Successfully Completing

Data from the 2015 global 'Program for International Student Assessment' (PISA) found that students who received positive feedback and self-belief from their teachers performed 68.2% better than students who had limited interactions with their teachers. Another study showed learner engagement was most successful when students were in an environment where they were frequently interacting and sharing what
